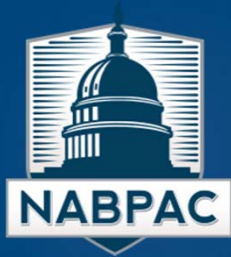

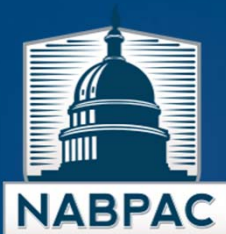
What would you say is your strongest skill?

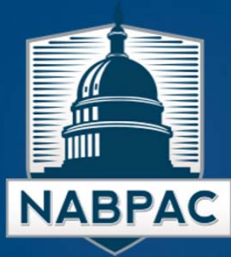

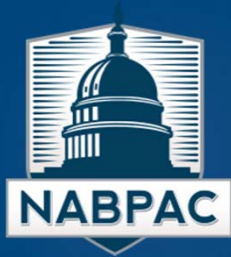
